Absences of 4 or more consecutive days must be pre-approved with the College. An exemption form will be required.

Non-Attendance Procedure

At enrolment all families agree to support their child/children to attend school regularly. Regular school attendance is crucial for academic success and personal development. Please be advised that the following process will be followed for all student with non-attendance, if 10 or more explained or unexplained absences are in a 5-week period:

- 1) Your child will be identified as 'at risk' due to non-attendance.
- 2) A letter will be issued to caregivers to inform the child being 'at risk' due to non-attendance and to improve attendance in a specified time frame.
- 3) If non-attendance continues, the Head of School will request a meeting (non-negotiable) to implement a support plan to increase attendance.

4) Continued non-attendance escalates to the Principal to discuss ongoing enrolment.

Homework

By setting homework in primary school, students develop a sense of responsibility, establish study habits and work ethic, establish & refine skills of time management and organisation and it encourages families to be involved in their child's school life and learning.

Homework can include English: Flash cards, Reading, LEXIA (online program), Spelling (spelling Mastery); in Maths: Times tables and IXL online program. The online learning programs (LEXIA, IXL) are provided free from the college, these are adaptive and improve and accelerate numeracy and literacy skills. Suggested time for homework per week:

Reception: 1.5hrs; Year 1: 1.5hrs; Year 2: 1.5hrs; Year 3: 2hrs; Year 4: 2hrs; Year 5: 2.5hrs; Year 6:2.5hrs

Book Packs/Stationery

Books and stationery are provided by the school as part of your fees. Any stationery needed during the year due to loss or use, is to be provided by families

Technology

Every student has access to a device in the classroom including headphones. In Year 5/6, students can bring their own headphones.

Mobile Phones

Each classroom is equipped with a safe. Students who come to school with a device must hand in their device at the start of the day. It is returned at the end of the day.
